MED TO ONE NOW OFFICIAL IN PERU

After a year and a half of negotiating the complex and cumbersome bureaucratic legal system of Peru, MED TO ONE - Peru is now a legally recognized entity in Peru. Having this official status will allow MED TO ONE - Peru to receive donations from organizations in Peru such as universities and churches. It will also allow the MED TO ONE coordinators to get discounts on the medicine they purchase at local pharmacies. Raquel Fabian, pictured with one of MED TO ONE's patients in Ayacucho, is MED TO ONE's Lima-based coordinator, and has been with MED TO ONE since its creation. She will serve as MED TO ONE - Peru's President.

While MED TO ONE has been legally recognized as a 501c3 non-profit in the United States since 2005, that status has no legal standing in Peru, and so a separate incorporation process was required. Thanks to Raquel for her perseverance in getting MED TO ONE registered.

One Gift to Break the Cycle: Give the gift of an Exam

Some of MED TO ONE'S patients are in a double-vicious cycle. Not only can they not pay for the medicine they need to stabilize their condition so they can work or go to school, some patients require a CAT scan of their brain so the doctors can determine the correct diagnosis and prescription. CAT scans can cost \$60 to \$100 dollars each, depending on various factors, including location of the exam. For an impoverished patient struggling to meet life's basic needs, it would be impossible to get an exam without MED TO ONE'S help.

MED TO ONE provides CAT scans to patients to enable them to get the initial diagnosis and prescription to enter the program. And, depending on the patient, a new CAT scan may be required periodically to re-evaluate their condition.

Giseli is one of MED TO ONE'S patients from Ica, Peru. She is due for a new CAT scan to update her prescription. When she was a child she was hit multiple times by her mother and has suffered from fainting spells, headaches and convulsions since. Prior to receiving support from MED TO ONE, she had been severely depressed because of her lack of control over her condition. Since MED TO ONE has been supporting her, Giseli has been doing much better, and is happy and grateful to MED TO ONE.

For just \$60 dollars, you can provide a CAT scan for a patient who requires one to get a valid prescription to start receiving MED TO ONE' support, or to allow one of MED TO ONE'S unsponsored patients get the exam they need to renew their prescription.

Ccacca is 11 years old and suffers from epilepsy. She is also developmentally retarded and has behavior problems. When Claudia was four years old, her mother brought her to the San Jose de Cotelongo school in Arequipa. She told the school that since her daughter was sick and couldn't walk, she couldn't work to provide for her and care for her. Her mother left her at the school and never returned. Schools like San Jose de Cotelongo have small budgets and aren't able to meet Claudia's medical needs. **MED TO ONE** will provide the medication that Claudia needs, and will follow up with her monthly.

What is MED TO ONE ?

MED TO ONE is a unique organization meeting the long-term needs of impoverished patients for the long term now. **MED TO ONE** focuses on patients in Latin America suffering from epilepsy, diabetes, hypertension, Parkinson's, etc.

Why is MED TO ONE so important?

In the countries where **MED TO ONE** serves, the socialized medical systems are terribly underfunded; medicine is generally not covered. Short term missions help fill the gap but do not meet the long-term needs of chronic sufferers.

Some patients—especially those with epilepsy—find themselves in a vicious circle where they cannot work or go to school because of their conditions, and they cannot work to pay for the medicine they need to live a normal life.

MED TO ONE can break this cycle and enable a patient to live up to their potential.

ONLY MED TO ONE meets the long-term needs of individual patients now.

MED TO ONE operates in Lima and Arequipa, Peru, Santa Cruz Bolivia, and plans to expand to Honduras soon.
